### SOS – A report by Chacko Jacob

I can never tire of testifying to God's greatness and goodness. The "SOS-Stress Of Souls" program held at Hotel Dee Cee Manor (T.Nagar) on March 17,2007 by the CFG fellowship is another great reason for me to testify of God's goodness.

To start with the main coordinator of the SOS program was Bro.John Daniel (JD) who joined CFG after our last program "Call To Excel". He has no previous experience in organizing such programs. The experienced CFG team members like Bro.Jabin stepped back and allowed JD to coordinate.

To our Lord's credit He did not leave JD who placed all his trust on Jesus alone. JD wondered how the money would come (Budget Rs.25000) but just one mail to the CFG fellowship and within a week he had commitments for Rs.17600. The very next week JD was testifying that our God is a great God. And true to his testimony – we never lacked anything in this program. All our financial needs were met. "Praise God"

We did not promote the program aggressively because we wanted to fill the hall through personal evangelism. We only printed 500 handouts/invitations. We only did one announcement in NLAG church in all the Sunday English services the previous week. We also **e-mailed the CCF members** and that's it. March 17,2007 also happened to be the first match for India in the cricket world cup. But, our God is a great God and he filled up Hotel Dee Cee Manor with 90 to 115 members. Almost 30% of the audience was Non-Christians / Non-Believers. I "Praise God" for the amazing turnout with such low promotional activity. The secret was that each CFG and CCF member made an effort and called their friends. "Praise God"

I also praise God that my secular presentation on STRESS was perfectly mated into Bro.Anand Jeypaul's evangelical message and many responded. Of the 90+ people who attended only 3 people responded in the negative to the feedback form question whether they would like to attend similar programs in future. This is fantastic feedback considering our mixed gathering .I give the Lord Jesus all the glory for this fantastic feedback. "Praise God"



I must share this testimony of one of Chennai's best trainers who attended this SOS program. He is a non-Christian man married to a believer woman. For 25 years of married life he never found the need to know Jesus whom his wife worshipped. After this program, as his 25th wedding anniversary gift he has decided to accept Jesus as the Lord and savior and get married again to his wife in a Christian Wedding. "Praise God". His simple reasoning is "If Jesus gives me the peace that takes away all stress in living – I want Jesus". "Praise God". There are many more testimonies like this on how God delivered people from stress during the SOS program. "Praise God"

To conclude - I must say that all we (CFG members) did is give Jesus our 5 loaves & 2 fish. It is Jesus who multiplied what we gave & fed the multitude during SOS.

## PRAISE REPORT

Philip Jesudasan (CCF Website) 2nd April 2007: An Evangelist named Sunil Jacob has been fatally wounded in an accident. Bro. Sunil Jacob belongs to a non-Christian family from Rajasthan. He was chased away from his family for accepting Christ as his personal Saviour. Now he is doing God's Ministry in a place called Paalapallam in Kanyakumari District. Last Wednesday (21.03.07) he met with an accident. A tipper lorry ran over him and he was fatally wounded in a place called Chunkankadai in Nagercoil. He is now in the Intensive Care Unit of Krishna Kumar Orthopedic Hospital (KKOH) in Nagercoil. His right leg was removed to save his life... Please pray for his speedy recovery and also pray that God should meet all his financial needs. Pray that God should use him mightily in the days to come.

16 April 2007 update: Mr. Sunil Jacob (formerly Sunil Dashrath Raja), a bachelor missionary in his forties has already undergone two major surgeries and again on 5th April he went through another painful skin grafting surgery. He is suffering from unbearable pain and he is under high-sedatives. Well-wishers are taking care of him in the hospital. The allotted room is Room No. 203. The hospital expenses are said to cross more than Rs.2,00,000/- (2 lakhs). The leg amputation surgery alone crossed Rs.50,000/-. Please mobilize prayer and financial support. Those who would like to help can do so on their own directly or their help can be forwarded.

19 April 2007 update: He is getting stabilized. His wound is deep and he is in great pain. He was crying but he is strong in faith. He wants to go out soon and spread the Gospel.

22 April 2007 update: Please pray for his infection to subside, it is quite severe & painful.

24 May 2007 update: After 65 painful days Bro. Sunil is back home. Thank you Dear Friend for praying and supporting him. Please inform all those who were praying.

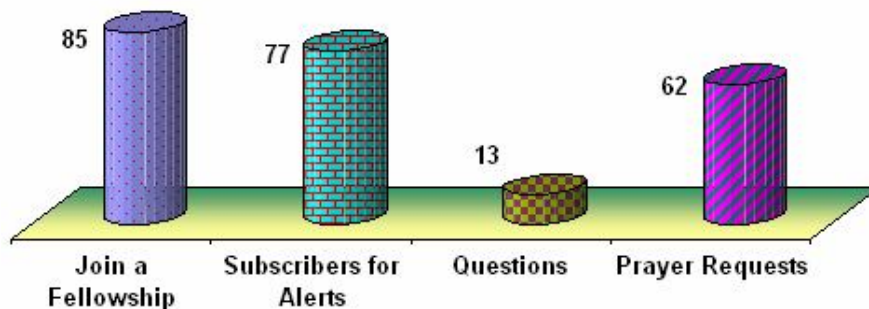
